Personal Equipment

- ___ 1 official uniform shirt
- ___

Please **remove Rank and leadership position** patches from your uniform:
- ___ 1 Scout shorts or switchbacks
(For Venturers, gray switchbacks or gray shorts at least mid-thigh in length)
- ___ 3 pair scout socks (crew-length) or equivalent for Venturers
- ___ Official BSA belt
- ___ Underwear for one week
- ___ 2 pair hiking socks
- ___ 2 T-shirts BSA type
- ___ Long-sleeve shirt
- ___ Warm pants
- ___ Warm sweater and/or jacket
- ___ Beanie
- ___ Rain jacket or poncho
- ___ **Hiking boots or shoes**
- ___ Sneakers
- ___ Towel
- ___ Wash cloth
- ___ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ___ Hand soap in container
- ___ Brush and/or comb
- ___ Chap stick
- ___ Sunscreen (*no aerosols!*)
- ___ Insect repellent (*no aerosols!*)
- ___ Hand Sanitizer (small bottle)
- ___ Sleeping bag
- ___ Air mattress or foam pad
- ___ Pen and pencil (*bring one or two extra*)
- ___ Watch (to last a week without recharging)
- ___ Small pocket knife (palm size or smaller)
- ___ Compass Flashlight or Headlamp
- ___ One (1) plastic 1-liter water bottle filled with water
- ___ Personal first aid kit
- ___ Personal medication (*Must be noted on your Annual Health form and turned in at check-in at camp. All medication must be in pharmacy issued containers with contents identification. No loose pills in plastic bags; no pill-boxes*)

Extra Required Items

- ___ Backpack adequate for carrying **ALL** gear to your campsite
- ___ Small Tent (participants may share a tent with one patrol member or sleep alone in a tent)
- ___ Small tarp/ground-cloth
- ___ **Small camp chair** (carryable)
- ___ Lunch for Sunday

Optional Items

- ___ Work gloves (*highly recommended*)
- ___ Camera (*non-cellphone based*)
- ___ Pillow
- ___ Pajamas
- ___ Teddy bear
- ___ Sewing kit
- ___ Sandals (for showers)
- ___ Small Notebook
- ___ Workout clothing

All items must be marked with your name.

Don't Bring:

- Food... *The critters will like you if you do!*
- Fireworks
- Fixed Blade or Large Folding Knives Laser
- Laser Pointers
- Mess Kit... *All plates, cups and utensils provided.*
- Walking sticks
- Electronics: Radios, Stereos, MP3 Players, iPods, Boom Boxes, Computers, Drones, Cell Phones, or any others
- Weapons of any kind (small pocket knife is permitted) Irreplaceable items you will be sad to lose.

After arrival in camp, 2 NYLT T-shirts, Cup, and 1 Hat are issued to all participants.
