



Dear Participant and parent/guardian for NYLT at Rancho Los Mochos, June 8 to 14,

The **NYLT** course scheduled from **June 8 to 14, 2025** at Rancho Los Mochos, south of Livermore, is less than 6 weeks away. We look forward to your attendance.

- 1) There is a **mandatory Orientation Meeting** on **May 8, 2025** at **First Presbyterian Church, Newark (35450 Newark Blvd, Newark, Ca 94560)** from 7:30 to 8:45 PM.
- 2) **Check-in starts at 6:15 PM**; please don't wait until after 7:00 to check in.
  - We have 192 participants and need time to check you all in and go thru the Orientation process.
- 3) **Scouts are expected to be in their full Scout Uniform.**
  - When you arrive, Scouts will be directed off in one direction while parents go in a separate direction
  - There will be a short interview for all participants
  - **This will be followed by a check of all of your registration information, with pictures taken, if necessary.**
  - **Expect this process to take 30 minutes due to all of the participants needing to be processed.**
- 4) **While the Scouts are going thru the interview and information checking, parents will proceed separately to turn in all medical forms.**

We **require** an **Annual Health and Medical Record form** for each participant, signed by a Medical Professional no earlier than June 1, 2024 (last June).

  - **These are to be turned in at the May 8<sup>th</sup> Orientation,**
    - i. *We will collect copies of whatever parts of the Medical you have (Part A, B1, B2, and C).*
    - ii. *We do need a copy of both sides of the Scout's medical insurance card*
  - **If not turned in on May 8, then all parts of the Medical must be turned in on arrival at Rancho Loas Mochos on June 8.**
  - The preferred turn-in time is at Orientation. It saves you and us a lot of subsequent emails to assure you bring everything to NYLT.
  - **Emailing these forms is NOT permitted, nor is mailing or hand-delivering them to Council Office.**

**If parents have any concerns on medical, food, or learning issues**, there will be a chance to discuss these with staff members either during check-in or at the end of the meeting.
- 5) Once we get Scouts processed and medicals turned in, the **meeting and presentation** will start about 7:30 and will cover:

- NYLT and its objectives,
  - Expectations – Conduct and consequences,
  - What to bring and not bring,
  - Medical form review and Medication reminders
  - Food issues reminders
  - Arrival at Rancho Los Mochos on June 8
  - Graduation Ceremony on June 14
  - Taking NYLT Home – setting 3 Goals
  - Open Question Period
- 6) While we provide 2 GGAC-NYLT t-shirts, some like to have extra ones to wear during the week. These can be ordered: [T-shirt ordering form](#). This form can be turned in at Orientation.

Again, we look forward to having you on the **NYLT course at Rancho Los Mochos** from **June 8 to 14** and to seeing you on **May 8 for Orientation** at the **First Presbyterian Church in Newark**. **Arrive after 6:15 but before 7 PM to allow for check-in processing.**
